#### SAN FELIX POSTPONED

WBIGDQ/CEØ (ref. TDXB 103, 104) is postponed until at least the end of September. While the official word will be "equipment problems" actually it is politics which are snagging things down in Chile. Apparently some military man euvers are taking place during September and no outsiders will be allowed on the island.

One major manufacturer has committed several transceivers to the operation and they are now stockpiled in Florida. This company will, in the future, limit its committments to expeditions which are properly authorized in advance and which are to spots in the top twenty or so in the latest TDXB needed listing.

There now exists the possibility that the San Felix team will arrive Chile about the time originally intended (Sep 12), go to Juan Fernandez first, thence to San Felix at the very end of Sept. It is also intimated that the San Felix operation will be very short and might even be all CW. Also, they now expect to be signing simply "/CEØ" from both spots, without the "Z" and "X" appended.

#### SAO TOME S9

Congratulations to Vince Thompson, K5VT, who did get licensed at and operate from Sao Tome last week as S9VCT. He did not know the length of his stay but expected it to be brief. Next action will be from Europe, most likely. "If everyone took tranquilizers, no one would need them."

#### MIDWAY ISLAND

Bill Myerson, NH6D, phoned to say he would be on from Midway and showed Aug 25. He forgot to specify how long the visit would last. Bill prefers CW but does have a mic along with his IC701.

#### WALLIS ISLAND

All bands 80-6 Meters, CW, ssb, and RTTY is on tap from Wallis by FK8DH, FK8DJ, and FK8CL Sep 11-18. They'll use a pair of IC720s with linears and the usual tribander and dipoles. Calls assigned are FWØBE (cw), FWØBF (ssb) and FWØBK (rtty and 6 Meters). QSL to DJ9ZB; contributions would be appreciated.

#### SABLE ISLAND

VEIAWS/1 is on from Sable until Sep 8. Hasn't shown on 80 Meters but was trying to get a dipole up for that band. He likes cw.

#### RUMORS

An Albania operation by EA2JG, EA2OP, and EA2AFZ Sep 5-12, to sign ZA2HFM.

F2CL to sign FB8WG Crozet for a year beginning mid-September.

Laccadives by same JA's who signed VU7AL/AN (and which isn't going to count).

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About that Laccadives business mantioned on p. 1. TDXB now has word from two totally different sources that the Andamans operation two weeks ago was indeed unauthorized, as the Indian government acknowledges no current licenses for the Andamans. Additionally, it is known that there are real, live pirates in that vicinity who make their base of operations the Laccadives, which are thus unsafe for visitors.

The Radio Club's operation from CEØ Easter Island will be Sep 2-8 by CE3DZ, CE3GN, and CE3GF, among others. 80-6 Meters are planned on ssb, cw and rtty. QSL to the RC of Chile c/b address.

Further to DJ6SI (TDXB 104)...Baldur now expects to start operating Sep 11 from Togo, followed by Volta, Camerouns, and Gabon. He does not know how long each stop will be. Mostly cw, his preferred mode. QSL DK9KD.

WA6YOU (formerly OD5MX) will leave shortly for a three-year assignment in India; that would give him time to meet the one-year residency requirement for a license. Ron has thoughts of VU7.

Karl Renz, K4YT, who is a technician in the U.S. Foreign Service, awaits his next traveling orders. He will be making over a dozen stops in various African countries this fall, and might leave as early as next month. This time he will make the same swing as in 1978, for those who care to check their logs from that year.

W4FRU mentions that he is QSL manager for all recent W4LZZ operations in Africa, including TYAll in June, 5T5ZZ, and 3XIZ.

We note with sadness the passing of David H. Houghton, who served the ARRL for fifty four years as QST Circulation Manager and later as treasurer of the League. He was laid to rest Aug 25. Mr. Houghton was not a ham, ever, in all those years.

W4MGN did, after all, finish his African tour as C5ACC, Gambia, despite the government's overthrow there (TDXB 102). The president is trying to regain his

control of things at this time. \*\*\*

FRØFLO is not talking about his rumored trip to Juan de Nova, either on the air or through the mails. Keep watching for the end of this month or first of Sep (TDXB 104).

Don't miss the September issue of QST; besides an Op News column on "DXCC Integrity" and a good How's DX section, the editorial by Assistant General Manager Sumner, KIZZ, is crucial. It concerns RFI and the FCC's attempts to lay the blame on us...guilty until proven innocent, as it were. Page 58 of the same issue has more details, including suggestions as to what individuals can do to help. Deadline for comments is Sept 30.

Another Sep 30 deadline is for the QST annual listing of DXCC members; get your latest cards into Newington for credit before that date.

It was mentioned that Gus Browning, W4BPD, will attend the DXPO 81 in Atlanta next month. Obviously, Gus has not met his schedule to leave on a long, 'round the world cruise and expedition. He had been talking about a July departure date and now is saying November.

Several A6 stations from the U.A.E. have been appearing again, but none count for DXCC until something changes within the country's licensing structure.

Look for a new prifix for Belize, now VP1, on or about Sep 21, their independence day.

Do you read the "Correspondence" in QST? S9VCT suggested to the pileup on 20 CW the evening of Aug 25 that they do, just before he gave up in disgust. He was referring to page 61 of Aug QST, titled "DX Rag."

#### EDITORIAL

ARRL's DXAC is pondering the proposed tightening of the CW mode DXCC award... some are wanting to require 2-way QSOs for credit to be given. Nothing may happen but the Board of Directors meets next month and talk is that some on that august body are hot for change and may force the issue.

It is strange that today voices are calling for encouragement of cw in much the same way that others hoped to foster voice operation thirty years ago. Remember "listen for my 'phone"? In light of what the bands sound like these days, and keeping in mind that everyone is free to choose their mode, is it legitimate to push one mode over another?

An argument can be made that asking another station to work 2-way cw might get the operator to dust off his key and then keep using it. But does it take a special award requirement to encourage such?
