#### CHINA

EDITOR'S NOTE: The recent visit to China by four members of the Boeing Amateur Radio Club was a joint activity with the Western Washington DX Club. The report in TDXB 108 was written before any official word had been received. Since then, a press release has been received from Philip Weaver, VS6CT, President of the Hong Kong Amateur Radio Transmitting Society, from which the following was excerpted.

The delegation (W7EA, K7HO, K7LAY, and KC7CF) was in China Sep 4-12, hosted by the Chinese Institute of Electronics. A four-hour slide presentation of amateur radio in the USA was made in each city visited. Unexpectedly, the group was allowed to make a contact with a representative of their home club...W7PHO. The Chinese advised that was "the first authorized amateur radio communication demonstration in more than 32 years." Three days later, on Sep 9, contacts between two Drake TR-7s, one in Beijing and the other in Shanghai were made. Operator Hsu Y.C. in Shanghai was licensed many years ago as XU8CH and C1CH.

The Chinese "Asked us to tell the world that their top government leaders are solidly behind amateur radio and, before too long, China expects to establish many friends throughout the world through the medium of amateur radio."

This event was publicized in the South China Morning Post newspaper. TDXB is grateful to VS6CT for making this material available.

# MORE CHINA

Once again, Tom Wong, VE7BC, is in the news, as he plans another trip to China Oct 1. Wong, a frequent business visitor in China, reportedly dictates ARRL's policy concerning amateur radio possibilities in China. About a year ago, Wong shepherded several thousand recent copies of ARRL's Radio Amateur's Handbook and some training materials into the country.

On this trip, VE7BC has arranged for twenty-five "goodwill kits" from ARRL to precede him. These kits consist of radio parts, headphones, etc. Wong will also be met in China by five Yaesu transceivers, four Hy-Gain yagi beams, and related equipment. These will be set up at four selected locations for future use. While it is remotely possible that an operation could commence while Wong is there, more likely it will be sometime in the future; Wong's next scheduled visit to China is in April, 1982.

W4LZZ is again operating 3X1Z; his first contact was Sept 18; he expected to be in Guinea until about Oct 1, and might also operate from Zaire and/or Mauritania.

VK9ZG continues active from Willis Is, only on 20 Meter SSB. He will be there until December.

And on October 1, Iris (W6QL) and Lloyd (W6KG) Colvin leave on another extended expedition. They have applications pending for licenses in "several rare countries," and will go to them if operating is possible. Otherwise, their itinerary includes Barbados, Trinidad, Fr. Guiana, Surinam, Guyana, and Curacao. Their plans are to be gone about six months, and they will be active in all four weekends of the CQ and ARRL contests (Oct, Nov, and Mar). All QSLs will as usual be handled by YASME, Box 2025, Castro Valley CA 94546.

(a) Each amateur radio station shall give its callsign at the end of each communication, and every ten minutes during a communication."

Nothing is yet known of IV30SH/5R8, on 20 SSB the afternoon of Sep 20 and again the following morning. He said to QSL to IV3MUC. The logical question is why would he be using his special Italian callsign when he could have simply signed I30SH? However, ARRL advises that there would be nothing improper for an Italian station out of the country to use a special prefix.

If you can tune 15.535 MHz, listen to "Chasing DX" on Radio Moscow, Sundays at 1300Z. Seems to be a new, regular program.

HS5ANI says the reason Thai stations were off the air for several weeks last month was that the government was having all amateurs register their equipment. This seems to be a prelude to the government issuing licenses. Up to now, calls in Thailand were assigned by the radio club in Bankok, to anyone who had attended a required three meetings of the club.

One correction to last issue's QSL listings...A22ZM is via ZS5CU.

A Prize to the second person to spot the major descrepancy between the list of bogus QSL cards from California (TDXB 107, p. 2) and the original letter from K6LPL (TDXB 93, p 2). K9FN was first to find it.

KICC hand delivered one of his SO3CC QSL cards. Printed in Poland and very classy. Rich says the one activity the Poles have going which we in the USA do not is a continuing 5-band DXCC listing. This has been proposed (endorsements for ARRL's five-band award) but nixed in Newington.

Andorra and San Marino have been admitted to membership in the <u>International Amateur Radio Union</u>; applications for such membership are pending from Djibouti and Bangladesh.

At last week's ARRL Board Meeting, the following items of interest to DXers came up: ARRL will increase activity in the Intruder Watch (Director Lewis); certificates for 5-band WAS and DXCC will be provided those not wishing to pay the nominal fee for a plaque (Milius); ARRL willhave a recommended Band Plan for 160 beginning Dec 1 (Holladay); and finally (fanfare, drum rolls)...

Director Zak moved and the Board VOTED "that the DX Advisory Committee study the viability of existing organized international operating activities and whether changes in structure or emphasis may be required."
