VK9XT and VK9XM (VK30T and K1MM) came

as scheduled Mar 10, but were not as strong in North America as they had been the week before from Cocos (VK9YM/YT). Propagation conditions and inferior antennas were blamed. They left Mar 17 and their two-stop operation is now complete.

KP2A/KP1 also opened on schedule, on Mar 16, and the group were plagued by the same poor conditions. They were workable mainly on 40-10 Meters, and the operation ended Mar 22.

JH2HDK and friends are saying they have a license for Bangladesh and will be on as S23JA or S23DX Mar 21-28. QSL to JH2HDK. (tnx DXPress).

4Z4TT said he couldn't get a license to operate from the Andamans this week, as he had planned. (Are you surprised?)

List operations for ZD9BV have improved greatly the past week or so, along the lines of our suggestions made in Issue 133. That may just be coincidental. The usual scheme is lists are made at 1800Z on either 21337 or 28940, and Andy shows at 1900Z on whatever band the list was made on. Occasionally he will be showing earlier and the list is made at 1630Z...the only way to know is to listen one day to the operation and get the set-up for the following day.

YI1AS QSLs from DK2OC for operations at year's end are dribbling out now... nothing busting loose on LU3ZY's backlog yet. JA2KLT/5R8 cards do not seem to be showing anywhere yet.
