SEVERAL IMPORTANT CHANGES AT TDXB:

- 1. We have cancelled the toll free "800" number, because almost nobody was using it. Thanks to those of you who did. Effective immediately the TDXB number is 203-871-7699, with a 24-hour answering machine.
- 2. We have extended the deadline for sending the Countries Needed Survey sheet (Issue 136) to June 1.
- 3. The box in the lower right corner of this page has a few changes regarding subscription rates. All new and renewing subscribers will have the option of paying extra for first-class mail delivery. Subscribers in the "48 states" wishing to switch immediately can do so by sending the difference for one year, Six dollars.

Yearly subscription rate for Canada, Mexico, Alaska, Hawaii, and U.S. possessions is increased to \$32 per year, and the rate for all others (airmail) is increased to \$40 per year.

A FEW COMMENTS on MELLISH REEF VK9ZR...
the operation by VK2BJL, EA8AK, and DJ9ZB
came on as scheduled, about 0900Z on May
7. A few of the locals who asked for
advice on working Mellish were advised to
listen at the usual times on the usual
bands when Australia comes through, and,
sure enough, there was Mellish. This was
a smooth operation, with emphasis on CW,
and no funny business. 48 hours into the
operation we were told that they had passed
the 8,000 contact mark, and they still had
three days to go.

The fact that there was less "policing" and other trash is directly attributed to the quality of the operation. One fly

in the ointment was noted among U.S. CW operators: some folks just wouldn't shut up long enough to listen, and there was far too much constant calling. When VK9ZR would say "W8?" (for example) many would not heed the selective call.

But it was ever thus. All in all, a super operation. QSL to VK2BJL.

RUMOR of a PYØ Peter and Paul Rocks expedition published elsewhere and listed in our Calendar last issue seems highly unlikely, considering the trauma in the Atlantic. You know that Ascension Island is being used as a staging area by the British...Ted Collins, ZD8TC, is reported to have returned to England. It is not known if this is a scheduled departure. Also, Andy, ZD9BV, has been pretty quiet the past couple of weeks.

SOME LOCALS are discussing an expedition to Canada's St. Paul Island in July of this year, and they're hoping to have eight contest-style operators aboard. More later.

If you worked ZF2FL in either of the past two CQ WW Phone Contests (in October) be sure to get the nice beachfront QSL card. Operator Jim Rafferty, N6RJ, is general manager of HRO Anaheim. HRO, incidentally, is reported to now be the number-two amateur radio retailer in the country, behind AES Milwaukee.

XZ5KNU/9 is the station of the KAREN NATIONAL UNION. Recall that XZ5A and XZ9A operate from the Karen State of Burma. If Burma turns out to be a Hot Spot soon we DXers won't be surprised.

The FCC Laurel Laboratory, which does equipment testing for the RF emissions of new equipment, will have its staff cut from 23 to five persons by early next year. This is the place which approves all those wonderful ham amplifiers which don't have 10 Meters included in them.

ARRL's Delta Division Convention in the World's Fair city of Knoxville May 22/23 will feature Don Search W3AZD conducting a DXCC forum, new ARRL President Vic Clark, W4KFC, Gary Dixon, K4MQG, first U.S. DXer to achieve 5-band WAZ, and Bob May, K4SE, who can officially check your QSLs for CQ Magazine's WAZ Award.

All those funny Canadian callsigns will count for something: the Canadian Constitution Certificate. You need to work 10 Canadians by the end of May and send certified log data to VE3LSS Radio Club, 155 Maitland Ave, Listowel ON N4W 2M4. Endorsements for a hundred contacts and/or all ten provinces. The special prefixes they've been using are VC, CY, and CK, as well as the usual VE, VO, VY.

Another activity coming up in the Great White North is the 1982 Northwest DX Convention, Vancouver, Jul 31/Aug 1, starring K5YY, N7ZZ (P41C), K4YT, and WB4ZNH. Get details from VE7WJ or VE7AZG.
