TOP TEN NEWS

Rumors of an Albania operation by a group of Spanish operators continue to pour in from every direction but Spain. It would be worth taking a look the first two weeks of August. Callsigns mentioned are EA8AK, EA2OP, EA2AA, EA2JA, and EA2JG, supposedly all having licenses.

Word also coming through from Martti Laine, OH2BH, that two Albanian nationals will visit him and OH5NW this Fall, to be "trained" in the mysteries of radio. They will then return to Albania with a complete a.r. station in hand. This seems to be a change in the former plan, which was to have the Finns do the training on-site in Tirana.

We don't know anything about that "VU7FN" who appeared on 20 CW the evening of Jul 26. Only W4 and W5 and perhaps WØ stations were hearing him (not a peep in W1) but the station claimed to be in the Laccadives.

At least one American operator has been chosen (tentatively) for the early-1983 VKØHI Heard Island operation. IDXF (International DX Foundation) officials have been corresponding with the VK6 DX Chasers Club regarding details like equipment. Their expertise is likely to contribute greatly to the success of the operation.

OTHER NEWS

A major publication had, for several months, the wrong dates for the August Worked All Europe CW Contest, and many of us picked it up from them. The correct dates are Aug 14/15. That mistake apparently spoiled the plans of the

group going to Market Reef, as they discovered the error too late to change their plans. OJØMA will still be active Aug 2-12, missing the Contest by two days.

OH2BNL/C9 will be joined in his United Nations duties in Mozambique by OH2MM the last week of August, for a full-bore operation using a pair of TR7's, L4B's, and beams. They plan to operate RTTY, too.

Latest word from IØMGM, the only reliable source on S.M.O.M., says 1AØKM will become active again around the middle of September, on weekends only.

Our Florida Good Radio Ears says a new Turkish operator is TAIMES, and he likes picture postcard-type QSLs send to "Erhan," Sozebesi No. 3 D7, Uskudar, Istanbul, Turkey. As usual, no mention of radio or callsign on your outer envelope.

Latest word on SMØAGD, Eric, is Nauru C21 late July, T3Ø early August, and Central Kiribati T31 in October. And Ron, ZLIAMO, is talking about the Fijis and Pitcairn VR6 in September.

IARU official SP5FM was allowed out of Poland a couple weeks ago to attend a convention in West Germany. He said they are "going very slowly" to try to get their gear back from the authorities and hope that would be the first step to reinstating amateur radio operating.

JA1DNG/YI has been heard very weakly in the States, around 1600Z on 21250, working Europeans. (Hey, Uli, where's our YI1AS QSL?).

TR80IT has an Equatorial Guinea license, 3C1JA, for Aug 25-30. The authorization is for SSB only, no CW, 80-10 Meters. Alain will use a TS130S with remote vfo for split frequency work, and a TA33 and dipoles. QSL to JA1LFR, Katsuya Kokubun, 4-22-6 Higiriyama, Kounan, Yokohama 233 Japan.

K4YT has finished up in Nigeria and heads for either TJ or TL now. Try 21300 at 1800 for his sked with KG3R.

You can always tell when there's been a full Moon. The following three items all came in the same day's mail: The Adrian Michigan Amateur Radio Club is going to Hell again this year, Aug 14/15. They say this year you can catch twice as much Hell as before, as the Berlin DX Club will operate from Hell, Germany, the same weekend, and they'll sign DLØPZ/p. The Michigan call is W8TQE/Hell.

OK, you want more? We've got it... Arizona's Desert Rats DX Club of Cochise County will be working Labor Day from (are you ready), Paradise Arizona. Sep 4-6, K7RDG, 80-10 CW and SSB. You will be eligible for a special certificate if you reach Paradise.

Finally, Dr. Don Miller, W9WNV, of some 1960's DXing fame, and who has been out on bail while appealing his 1980 conviction of conspiring to have his wife murdered, was arrested July 13 for allegedly stealing a pair of shoes from a Sears store in Indio, California. Miller claimed his charge card wouldn't go through the card machine because it was "warped," and he thought the shoes had been paid for. Sears thought otherwise.
