## CONGRESS ACTS IN AMATEUR RADIO MATTERS

Communications bills affecting amateur radio were passed by both the U.S. Senate and House on August 19 and sent to the president for his signature. Important points were:

1. (Clarified) the reservation of exclusive jurisdiction to the FCC over matters involving RFI (radio frequency interference). This means that local RFI ordinances which have been enacted in communities (such as Burbank IL, TDXB Issue 142) will not be enforceable in the courts.

2. (Would give) FCC the authority to require that home electronic equipment and systems be so designed and constructed as to meet minimum standards for protection against unwanted radio signals and energy. Existing equipment would be exempt from any regulations to be set later.

3. (Would extend) amateur radio license terms from five to ten years.

4. Volunteer examiners will be allowed to administer amateur radio operator license examinations. The examiner would have to hold a higher class than that he is giving the exam for, except that Extra Class amateurs will be allowed to administer the Extra Class exam.

\*All the above will probably have been signed into law by the time you read this; on a related topic, FCC Chairman Fowler's reply to the letter from Senators Goldwater and Schmitt (TDXB Issue 154) requesting interim permission for U.S. amateurs to operate on 10 MHz was that FCC will issue an NPRM in the "early Fall" and it is possible the NPRM could be acted on immediately, allowing 10 MHz operation on a limited basis (probably low power, CW only, on a non-interference basis). About forty countries have use of 10 MHz, which was made available by the WARC treaty of 1979, almost three years ago.

TDXB: 203-871-7699

TWO CHICAGO-AREA DXers worked BY1PK the first of Aug, and got their QSL cards in thirteen days! The contacts into the East Coast reported last week were apparently a hoax.

No official word out yet from EA8AK about how his visit to Albania early in Aug went; nor is the Peter/Paul Rocks expedition mentioned last week giving any official dates for the trip yet. The Heard Island organizers are hoping now to make their financial goal for the January/February 1983 operation (VKØHI).

Mozambique SMØMLL/C9 and Iraq JA1DNG/YI continue (see Bandpass) but still not acceptable for DXCC credit. DXCC submission turn-around time has been running about seven weeks, for QSLs which are acceptable.

Last winter, organizers of the 1AØKM operations from the Sovereign Military Order of Malta were saying the first autumn airing of the station might come around mid-September; a reminder that the European Phone Contest is Sept. 11/12 (same weekend, unfortunately, of the W9DXCC Convention).

SMØAGD is now active as FWØAG from Wallis; Eric plans stops at 5W1 Samoa, ZM7 Tokelau, and KH8 American Samoa, in Sept, hoping to finish at T31 and KH1 in October.

A71AD planned a 40-Meter beam-raising party for Aug 27 and plans big things on 7 MHz this winter. Several Z21 stations are saying to not mention "Salisbury" (the capital city) when you address envelopes there; no reason given. 3B8SJ was a scout jamboree (third annual) assisted by special stations 3B8DX and 3B8CM. DK2OC forwarded STØAS QSLs to WB4LFM, for mailing within the U.S. These cards are for contacts over a year ago. ZL1AMO has IRCs available for 40 cents each; U.S. checks sent to his c/b address OK.

John Ackley, KP2A, of the International DX Foundation, will activate St. Pierre as FPØJA Sep 4-10, concentrating on CW. QSL to WB2MSH.

A couple of years ago we carried several stories on amateur radio in Turkey, the principal facts being that although amateur radio has officially been illegal there since the 1930's, many active hams do get on and operate, keeping a low profile. All this may change in the near future, however, as a new law has been written and is expected to be signed by the Turkish president sometime in September. Included in the law are rules for amateur radio, thus making our hobby legal there once again. For now, it will continue to be necessary to avoid mentioning callsigns on envelopes going to Turkey.

The above points out a strange bit of reasoning on the part of somebody...or at least a possible contradiction. ARRL's DXCC accepts QSLs from TA stations because while amateur radio isn't legal in Turkey, it is not specifically illegal, either. In cases such as Mozambique and Burma, while authorities have unequivocally stated that amateur radio is not allowed, nobody is being arrested for such operations. Some would say that such a policy amounts to tacit approval, i.e., that the authorities just don't care.

Expeditioners will want to know that the West Gulf Amateur Radio Club (Houston) is making available for loan the following: (4) IC701s, an IC251, and an IC551.
