NO-CODE LICENSE?

INFORMATION: ARRL last week sent letters to some 800 U.S. amateurs, urging them to write their Federal representatives concerning FCC's proposed nocode amateur license. Those included in the mailing were assistant directors, section managers, public relations assistants, etc. The letter cites the four FCC rationalizations for a no-code license, then suggests arguments against the rationalizations. "Form letters" are discouraged, as they have little impact among the recipients, compared to original letters. You can get a copy of the letter by sending a postcard or phoning ARRL Headquarters.

MT ATHOS: As we go to press things are looking good for the rumored Jun 25 operation. In a letter to ARRL, the "expedition team" of SV2s PKA, PUA, JJA, KFA, OTA, and QPA hoped to activate Mt Athos Jun 25-30. No modes or bands were specified. The team says they "met a lot of difficulties from the authorities of Mt Athos" but they are hoping for the best. We could be wrong, but judging from the callsigns we'd bet there will be little if any CW operation. There was no QSL manager specified.

Another publication last week reported rumors of operations from San Felix (no date), 70 S. Yemen by J28AZ in August (haven't we heard that one before?), and Viet Nam by CO20M in August!

 $\underline{\text{IRCs}}\ldots\text{both}$  ZL1AMO and WlFJ have IRCs available at 40 cents each.

TDXB Survey: please note that the deadline has been extended to July 1. We would very much like to beat the 700 or so returns we have had each of the past three years. We haven't looked at them very closely yet, but we predict that China will still be the #1 Needed Country, despite the past year's operations by BY1PK and BY8AA. This is at least in part due to the hams who have worked those stations even though they didn't need China!

CAMBODIA: As reported earlier, JAlUT and JAlHQG met Cambodian Prime Minister Son Sen in Cambodia back in May; a few weeks ago, Son Sen visited in Tokyo where another meeting took place. Pictured below are JAlUT and a relative of Son Sen. The relative is interested in amateur radio and may be the first licensee. Below that is a photo of "Tokyo Village" in Cambodia, probably the site of the proposed station. JAlUT and JAlHQG are providing an FT77, FL2100B, and \$2000 to get the operation underway, but no dates of operation have been announced yet. (Thanks to JHIFDP of The Japan DX News).

Another publication claims that, according to JH3DPB, several JAs have received an XU license for Aug 10-31. No confirmation of this.





PACIFIC INTER ISLAND DX NET is meeting at 0800Z on 14250; a recent morning the net hosted three KX6s, KC6AT, KHØAC, KC6MM, T3ØBY, KG6JHH, P29JM, KC6JC, KC6QM, and WH2ADE!

KH6LW/KH7 <u>Kure</u> rumored to have started a two-week operation Jun 16, but no reports on him yet. He usually operates QRP and is quite weak in N.A.

According to DK2EI and other sources, DJ2BW and DL8DC will activate TZ8DC Jul 14-24.

 $\underline{\text{OSCAR}}$   $\underline{10}$  (Phase 3B), launched Jun 16, should be operational in 4-6 weeks. The bird was released slightly askew, and it will be about two weeks before it is in position for the final positioning rockets to be fired. It is working, with a beacon on 145.812 around  $00\text{-}0\overline{2}\overline{z}$ .

5R8AL is back on from Malagasy, most recent report being 21330 at 1600Z on Jun 20. S21BTF is showing on both SEANET and the VK/ZL Openhouse Net (1200Z/14310) but more documentation is needed in Newington before it'll count. TI2J is talking about a Cocos operation later this year; many 6-Meter operators worked W6JKV/TI9 in mid-June. He did not appear to have operated anywhere below 50 MHz. W4MGN has left for his annual summer swing through Africa, first stop being the usual: Dakar, Senegal. After that his itinerary is in doubt, and operations will depend on available equipment in each country. K4YT will also be in Africa in July/August, and we'll have his schedule shortly.

DXPO 83 will be in Atlanta again this year, Sept or early Oct. More details soon. This event is evolving into being held every-other-year in Atlanta and every-other-year in the D.C. area.

### SPACE SHUTTLE

Plans are firming up for astronaut Owen Garriott, W5LFL, to operate from the Shuttle in October, on 2 Meters. It is said 500 2-way contacts will probably be the max, and the best set-up will be 10-20 watts to a "turnstile" antenna. W5LFL will be using a homemade rig, to NASA specifications, with an aerial taped to a window of the spacecraft. There will be QSLs available for both making contact and for SWLing.
