KERMADEC: several weeks ago we mentioned that ZL3AFH was expecting to be assigned to Kermadec this year. RSGB's DX News Sheet has Warwick (now signing ZK1WL) on Kermadec by September, but not on the air until next January.

K4YT, back only two weeks from his assignments in Asia, won't leave for Africa until late August or early September. An itinerary will be available at that time.

BV2B is said to be changing his operating day from Wednesdays to Thursdays. Try CW around 14.040 at 1400Z, and SSB with W7PHO on 14.225 at 1500Z. He does not hear very well, so if his signal is weak your chances of a contact are not very good.

W8IQ showed unannounced operating CW from TJ1GH on Jun 25. That's the station of DL9ZAX, who apparently is active on SSB only. W8IQ was denied a TJ license during his stay in Cameroun.

TO THOSE who have responded to our solicitation for early subscription renewal---Thanks! It is a big help.

YI1BGD made what would have to be termed a fabulous appearance on Jul 3, with operator Saad much louder on 21284 than the usual signal on 20 Meters. He worked by call areas but skipped several of them. We have waited eight months, in vain, for our QSL. Neither IRCs nor money worked.

DON'T phone us if you hear China...your editor finally worked BY8AA Jul 3. It took so long mostly because their 0100Z time slot doesn't fit our current biorhythms. But nobody ever said that working a Novice on the other side of the globe under poor propagation would be easy! We have mentioned that the BY1PK operators were aware of the path to North America around 1300Z... but in a recent letter operator Tong stated that they are completely off the air 1100-1500Z due to TVI problems.

SOUTH YEMEN: Several amateurs have offered to supply J28AZ equipment for a 70 operation, if he can supply operating permission which will pass the DXCC inspection by August 24. The information we published previously still stands. It is understood that the authorities would allow operation on two fixed frequencies, 14.195 and 21.295, SSB only, no split frequency.

CLIPPERTON: despite what you may hear elsewhere, the date of the upcoming operation is January, 1984. Several U.S. operators are tentatively signed up, but ask to remain anonymous until final (financial) commitments are made.

CAMBODIA: the rig being supplied by JAIUT and others is expected to be on site sometime in August. They have suggested the callsign XUISS (for San Son).

ALBANIA: DL7FT and DJØUJ are still looking for financial support for a September 1983 Albania operation. They need \$500-\$1000 to get into Albania with gear, and believe operating permission would be given once they are inside the country. Incidentally, nothing has been heard re the efforts of the Finnish society to train some Albanian operators and to set up a university station. DL7FT's address is Frank Turek, PO BOX 1421, D-1000 Berlin 19, West Germany.

DXCC: The current crop of S2BTF contacts DO NOT count for ARRL DXCC. No valid paperwork has been received for any S2 operations since January, 1982. ARRL has requested documentation from S2BTF. NONE of the Mozambique C9 operations from the past few years (SM2DWH/C9, etc) count for DXCC, either. And the DX Advisory Committee is just about to vote on the possible deletion of Spratly from the DXCC List. Their vote, as always, will constitute a recommendation to the Headquarters.

CONFESSION: In Issue 191, the editor said he had "307 out of 318" current DXCC countries. That was pretty dumb, since the current countries total is 315. Serrana Bank, Bajo Nuevo, and the Saudi Arabia-Iraq Neutral Zone were deleted a year ago. We guess we are typical in that we have given up counting what we <u>have</u> and just pay attention to what we $\frac{\overline{\text{don't}}}{\overline{\text{don't}}}$ have! With China in the log, we $\frac{\overline{\text{don't}}}{\overline{\text{don't}}}$ have ten current countries. If they delete Spratly we won't have nine current countries, and we guess that would mean we could waltz onto the Honor Roll through the back door.
