CAMBODIA: XUISS continues to work a handful of North American stations each Sunday morning, around 1130Z, on 14.336 with VS6CT assisting. According to the newsletter of Japan's DX Family Foundation, attacks by the Vietnamese resulted in the station being off the air sixteen days; they came back on May 2. Many of the people originally in the Ampil village are still some 10 kM from the site, but operators Righ, Au, and YL Kimsan put the station on the air "most every day." Aside from the list operation mentioned above, XUISS also reportedly works a DK9KE net on 21.157 at 0900Z and 14.005 CW at 11-1300Z on weekdays. They have been heard on that CW frequency in the 'States but few if any contacts have resulted. Please send only one QSL to JAIHQG, and be patient, as the logs often take several months to reach him.

NIGER: 5U7LD is Lucio, 5N8LED; he suffered from a "viral infection" last week and was off the air but is expected again the week of Jun 18. He works only nets, primarily 14.236 at 0200Z and 21.335 at 1800-1900Z. QSL IN3RZY.

CENTRAL KIRIBATI: T31AT by T3ØAT now scheduled to begin Jun 18 for about a week.

RUMORS of a PYØ Fernando de Noronha operation in July are making the circuit. PYØ Trindade is the one most needed, however, and our San Francisco desk reports that something may be happening on that one later this year. PY3ZZ and PY3BXW are mentioned.

MORE RUMORS: this one about a Glorioso operation, FR7ZD/G, to begin around Jun 20. This will probably be another one available only on lists and nets. If so, considering the demand for Glorioso, it stands to be a disaster.

MORE AFRICA: Bert, WD5AJE/SU, is showing on 20 and 40, with a better signal on the lower band. He says QSL to Bert, Sinai Mission Radio Club, APO NY 09679...S. Sudan TL8GE/STØ still showing on the nets...3X4EX says his license has temporarily expired and as a result he is now signing 9L1EX/3X, which may not be countable for DXCC...

LORD HOWE by G3ZAY and G3CWI (VP8ANT) starts Jul 10 for a week, including the IARU Radiosport Contest. They do not know the callsign yet. QSL Box 146, Cambridge England.

TAIWAN BVØJA and BVØYL ran Jun 8 to 18, with primary activity on CW; they worked 40-10 Meters, plub 144 and 430 MHz, and possibly Oscar 10 Mode B. As usual, they were not allowed to contact amateurs in the USSR or the People's Republic of China. QSL to JGlQGT, DXFF, PO BOX 12, Ochiai, Tokyo 161 Japan. And look for another operation by visiting amateurs this fall, probably including some from the U.S.A.

SPRATLY: DUICK's proposed operation looking more and more in doubt. Associated Press news reports say China has not only reinforced its troops along the border with Viet Nam (which claims many of the Spratly Islands) but that China has also "ferried 2,000 marines to the Spratleys." AP correctly reports what we mentioned here over a year ago...both China and Vietnam are occupying islands in the Spratleys. The report concludes that China/Viet Nam tensions have increased since Hanoi and Moscow staged a naval exercise near the port of Haiphong back in April.

PITCAIRN: VR6KY has a sked with her QSL Manager, NE5C, Mondays and Thursdays, 21.305 at 2200Z. WD9GQV is home in Illinois after her proposed VR6 operation was scrubbed.

MT ATHOS: reports from Europe are that last week's DJ5CQ/SV/A operation was legitimate. It was a battery-powered operation, eliminating much of the usual hassle of having to take a generator up the mountain.

DX ADVISORY RECOMMENDS "NO" ON 4U1VIC,

"YES" ON BAKER AND HOWLAND

ARRL's DX Advisory Committee has completed voting on DXCC country status for the Vienna International Center (4UIVIC) and on a new "country" of Baker and Howland Islands (see TDXB Issue 239). 4UIVIC was not recommended to the Headquarters but Baker/Howland was. Following letter from the Northern California DX Foundation explains:

"There has always been something strange about Baker, Howland, and American Phoenix Islands. The United States and the United Kingdom both claimed the eight Phoenix Islands for many years, in conflict with each other. In order to resolve the dispute, in 1939 the two countries agreed to joint administration of two of the islands, Enderbury and Canton Islands. This was expanded to include Hull Island in 1970. Because of this joint arrangement, a station located on Canton Island could be licensed by the British as a VR1, and contacts with that station counted for the DXCC country of the British Phoenix Islands. That very same station, in the very same location, could also be licensed as a KB6 (later KH1) and contacts under the U.S. call would count for the DXCC country of Baker, Howland and American Phoenix Islands. In 1979 the Republic of Kiribati was created, and the DXCC country of British Phoenix Islands became Central Kiribati. The dispute between the U.S. and the United Kingdom then became a dispute between the U.S. and Kiribati.

"Then, in late 1979, the U.S. and the Republic of Kiribati signed a treaty of friendship, in which the U.S. renounced all claims to the Phoenix Islands. The treaty was ratified by the U.S. Senate in June, 1983, signed by President Reagan in July, and finally formally enacted in September 1983. Now that the treaty is in force, KHl licenses are no longer issued in the Phoenix Islands. The DXCC country presently known as Baker, Howland, and American Phoenix Islands therefore now consists only of Baker and Howland Islands, which have never been in dispute and were not affected by the treaty.

"So what? one might ask. How can that affect DXCC. Well, we believe that the course of events calls for deletion of the present DXCC country of Baker, Howland, and American Phoenix Islands, and the creation of a new DXCC country of Baker and Howland Islands. The reason we believe this should be done is as follows:

"The treaty removes from American jurisdiction fully 90 percent of the land area and 100 percent of the populated areas of the old DXCC country of Baker, Howland and American Phoenix Islands. This is, by any reasonable measure, a massive change to the DXCC country. Also, Canton Island, the spot of land from which nearly 100 percent of all postwar DXCC credited contacts have been made is no longer under American jurisdiction. If the ARRL does not delete the present country then DXers

who already have credit would maintain credit even though Canton Island, the location with which their contact was made, is no longer American soil and is no longer within the boundaries of the country for which credit is given. We don't think that makes sense, and that the only action that does make sense is to delete the old country, which has undergone massive change, and create a new country consisting of Baker and Howland Islands only."

The DXAC vote in this matter was close, sources say. It now remains for the Headquarters to approve or disapprove the recommendation. A deletion will not affect anyone's Honor Roll standing until an operation takes place from the new DXCC entity.

FPØRH will be active from St Pierre starting Aug 3, mostly CW, by three New England-types... HH2VP (N4XR) no longer resides on Haiti but plans to return several times a year for the major CW contests...PY2PE was asked point-blank on Jun 14 if 5U7LD has proper licensing and she said "yes"...K3ZO is home in Maryland after an assignment of several years in Bogota...G6ZY returns to EA6 Balearic Islands the last two weeks of July...CEØFCM/CEØ is gone from Juan Fernandez; CEØEVG continues until year's end...Rumors of a KP5 operation keep popping up, latest being July dates...

XZ5A and XZ9A, in the Karen State of Burma, have generated a lot of interest the past few years, even though Newington does not recognize them for DXCC (and rightly so, as the Karen State is officially part of Burma and Burma specifically has banned amateur radio). A recent article in Soldier of Fortune Magazine (no, we don't subscribe to that!) says the warfare between Karens and the central government has been going on for forty years. commander-in-chief of the Karen National Liberation Army claims that the Rangoon government is using U.S.-supplied UH-1 ("Huey") helicopters, provided by the Americans for "drug traffic control," to bombard the Karens. The article also notes that the Karens were U.S. allies in WW2 and that the population is nearly all Christian (instead of Buddhist). Something to keep in mind when you look at that XZ5A or XZ9A QSL card!
