CHINA: BY1PK appeared as scheduled with DU9RG Aug 11 on 14.155; the optimum time for them now appears to be 1230Z. On the 11th, DU9RG worked mostly from a "list" sent to him by a radio club on the East Coast. Another schedule was made for same time and frequency Saturday, Aug 18.

Last year this group made 7,000 contacts from L.H. Operators VK2WU, VK3CE, VK5ARO, VK2CIA, and VK2AD will use three complete KW rigs in the multi-transmitter contest category.
