THIS ISSUE written (and mailed) three days later than usual for a more timely report on the CQ WW DX CW Contest (Nov 24/25). You will receive Issue 266 four days from now. Contest propagation was about as expected, better on Sunday than Saturday, with the Solar Flux on a seven day, ten point upswing. Band openings were there but you had to hustle to find them. Ten Meters tried to open E/W, without success...in W1, CT2FN was S9 for about an hour on Sunday, but only a handful of continental Europeans were worked, on backscatter. Fifteen did not have the deep European opening it had a month ago during the Phone contest, and, again, no JAs heard east of the Mississippi. Twenty Meters was very flaky; at times the band was populated almost entirely with USSR stations who, by the way, came out in droves.

The Low Bands were no better than they had been on phone, although contact totals were higher, as they always are on CW. JA/U.S. East Coast was a particularly good path on 40, and 160 was little better than it had been the Phone weekend, and not nearly as good as it has been at times the past two months.

Probably the best expedition station was DK7PE, who finished his Rodrigues operation on Saturday and then showed for more contest operation Sunday from Mauritius, DK7PE/3B8, on his way home to Germany. N6TJ apparently signed EA9CE, as EA9KF was also heard over the weekend; N6ZV operated all bands as FY0GA. Others heard were HH2VP (W1EOB), 9Y4W, 4V2C, FM/W6SZN, C53J (F6DYG, who was workable Sunday on 10), CT1BCM (OH2BH), N3RD/VP9, YB0ARA (OH2MM), and 9Y4VT.

Two propagation generalities noted over the weekend...often the skip was very long. On 10, LU and CX stations had good signals when nothing was coming through from Central or Northern South America. Sunday afternoon on 20, central Europeans faded, while far-north UA1ZD was S9, and KL7RA popped through at the same time. And when bands did open to populated areas, there were few "runs" to be made...examples were 40 into Europe about 2200Z (good openings both days) and 20 into Japan at the same time...strong signals but not enough of them.

BOUVET: A South African scientific team will be making repairs to various Antarctic weather stations in December, and ZS6BK is trying to get passage on the ship for a short stay on Bouvet; the ship isn't scheduled to stop at Bouvet but passes very close by, and Bill will get them to drop him off on their way down and pick him up on the return trip if his request is granted. There is still no word from Norway about whether an amateur will be stationed at Bouvet for a longer period of time next year.

MARION ISLAND is also possible soon; ZR6AOJ will definitely be assigned to one of the weather stations...might be ZS2MI, or it might be ZD9 Gough or in the Antarctic. He has requested Marion. ZR6AOJ is a VHF licensee and does not know CW; the authorities have given him special temporary permission to use the HF bands while on island assignment. He is "not a DXer," (but neither were Max and Fernando when they landed on San Felix back in September). ZR6AOJ's assignment will begin in January, will last one year, and we should know in another week or two which island he will be on.

IOMGM has officially announced another S.M.O.M. 1A0KM operation for Dec 8/9, for 48 hours, to include 160 Meters and Oscar. Try 03-0400Z on 160. The following weekend, 1A0KM is scheduled to be on again, almost exclusively RTTY and AMTOR.

AH6FG will activate rare Kalawao county Hawaii Dec 14-17, 160-10 Meters, both CW and SSB, with seven operators: WH6AYM, AH6CO, KH6DD, WH6F, AH6FG, KH6GDR, and WH6O. Kalawao County, only twelve square miles, is a triangular piece of land on the island of Molokai; it is at sea level at the base of a 1600-foot cliff, and access is by boat, small plane, or mule ride down from the top of the cliff. However, the county line with Maui county is at the top of the cliff and there's just room for two tents and a car; that's where the AH6FG operation will take place, on the edge of the cliff.

FB8XAD appeared on schedule from Kerguelen, operator FB8WK on his way home from Crozet and showing on 40 Meters CW Nov 19. He used FB8 instead of FT8 because the French callsign changes aren't mandatory until Jan 1. There is still a chance that another operator will be on Kerguelen late December or early January, for a stay of several months.

INDIA's "Garden City Contest" is 1200Z Dec 15 to 1200Z Dec 16, 20 and 40 Meters CW only; work VUs (once per band) and exchange the usual RST plus three-digit serial number for points. Logs to Bangalore ARC, PO BOX 5053, Bangalore 560 001 India.

EHRHORN TECHNOLOGICAL OPERATIONS says rumors that they are going out of the amateur radio business and/or selling off their amateur equipment operations are "simply not true." Nearly a year ago, ETO began a contract to build some commercial equipment, and amateur amplifier production has been delayed as a result. ETO says they have "tripled the size of the ETO plant" and they expect to move into the new facility in December; shortly after that, they will resume deliveries of amplifiers. They plan to begin production of the Alpha 85 "as soon as possible."



FIVE YEARS AGO IN THE DX BULLETIN

Closing date for the WARC was extended to Dec 5, as frequency allocation groups had fallen behind schedule; word was still good concerning new amateur bands. KA1BQ announced upcoming operations from the Central African Republic (TL) and the Congo (TN), to include KA1BOH and 18MPO. TN8AJ was active on CW but very slow and elusive. K1MM/3B8 was on, followed by FROMM in the CQ WW CW Contest; Bill was also trying to get a 5R8 license. ZL1ADI was rumored on his way to China, with hopes of operating permission, and the Radio Club Concepcion (Chile) was organizing a Juan Fernandez operation for January 1980. VKOPK ended a Macquarie operation with 3300 contacts. S2BTF was appearing on the 21.340 "Family Hour" net a couple of times a week, but only two stations from each U.S. call area were listed each time.
