CHINA REPORT

PROPAGATION: Feb 1,2,3, High Normal; Feb 4, Low Normal; Feb 5, Disturbed; Feb 6, Below Normal; Feb 7, 8, Low Normal; Feb 9, High/Low Normal; Feb 10, 11, 12, High Normal. TNX N4XX.

K1MM, on another of his visits to China, operated from BY4AA, Shanghai, Jan 21. Bill negotiated for operating times which he hoped would coincide with band openings to the Eastern part of the United States. During the 2130-0100Z time frame (very early morning in Shanghai), there were no signals at all from Stateside; Bill worked a handful of Europeans and several hundred JA's.

The 0830-1200Z slot was more productive; W4DR opened 40 Meters at 1000Z and BY4AA managed to work several dozen East Coast stations, with the peak occurring about 1100Z. Bill moved down to 80 at 1130Z and worked K5UR and W0ZV. This was at Shanghai sunset and East Coast U.S. sunrise. The beam heading for Shanghai from Connecticut was, incidentally, due south.

At 1200Z with a 6-element beam at BY4AA, 20 Meters was absolutely dead; the reasoning is that after dark that band goes dead in China, just like everywhere else.

There are currently six licensed BY stations...BY1PK and BY1QH from Beijing, BY4AA at Shanghai, BY8AA at Chengdu, BY5RA and another BY5(?) from Fuzhou. A license has been issued for a BY7 at Guangzhou, and equipment is on hand, but the station location is currently tied up in the local city bureaucracy. BY8AA is reported still on the air, although it has not been heard Stateside for over a year.

K1MM delivered packages of log sheets and information for all the ARRL and CQ contests; there is still considerable interest among the Chinese operators for contests, but they claim to simply not understand how to go about participating.

BRIEF NOTES

Our assumption (Issue 272) about the new Honor Roll plaques was correct: you must have appeared in the QST Honor Roll listing to be eligible to buy a plaque(\$25). The next listing will be this coming June...an excellent opening to India from the U.S. East Coast occurred at 0130Z Jan 21, and it was aided by the fact that the "alligators" had all vacated 3895 to watch the Super Bowl!...5R8AL appeared on 40 CW, running his own list. Take a listen, it's weird...YB5ASO is back home in Houston after an extended stay on Sumatra; he was a beacon on 40 and 80 CW the past two winters. His QSL manager is still W4BBP...DJ6SL, not successful in TL or TN, is in Togo Feb 1-15, hoping for 5V operating permission...while some of our reliable European sources swear that LA4CG is on a ship in the Antarctic, a couple of Stateside DXers claim to have letters from Norway which say just the opposite, that there're no hams on any Norwegian ships in the area...WB6FCR is going to VP2V for the ARRL Phone DX Competition, and members of the Ill-Wind Contest Club (Chicago area) will activate J8 St. Vincent Feb 20 to Mar 5, which includes the CQ 160 Meter Phone activity and the ARRL DX Phone Competition...7Q7LW is in England but said to be returning to Malawi any day now...

ARRL BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

(January 24/25) The Board was in receipt of a communication from the U.S. Department of State, saying that it proposed to sign a treaty with the Vienna International Center, 4U1VIC, allowing third party traffic with the U.S. It was the feeling of the Board that if such a treaty were ratified, the U.S. would then consider the V.I.C. a "separate country," and the ARRL should also, for purposes of DXCC. The DX Advisory Committee of the League did not have this information when it recently recommended against 4U1VIC being counted as a separate DXCC country.

The Board referred the 4U1VIC matter back to the DXAC for reconsideration...a move which was technically not necessary because the Advisory Committee would have eventually reconsidered the matter anyway (when and if a treaty were signed).

A motion that DXAC recommendations on DXCC matters be referred to the Board, bypassing Headquarters, was tabled. The general feeling was that the Board simply didn't want, or need, this additional work, work which has been handled for years by the paid staff.

The new chairman of the DX Advisory Committee is Bob Thompson, K6SSJ. This appointment is traditionally made the first of January, and the fact that it came while the Board was meeting was coincidental.

Another motion was to ask the DX and Contest Advisory Committees for input on the possibility of allowing awards credit and contests on the soon-to-be opened 24 MHz band. This also would have been done in the normal course of events. The motion was tabled.

Sources told TDXB that further attempts by some Board members to remove decision-making from the Headquarters have been put on hold, at least for the time being.

However, the Board's standing committees have been re-organized, to more closely parallel the new Headquarters management structure; there are now four standing Board committees (instead of three), the new one being a Membership Services Board Committee.

FIVE YEARS AGO IN THE DX BULLETIN

(February 4, 1980): Jim Smith, P29JS, reported that a ship was on its way to Heard Island, and that there were no hams aboard but apparently there was a Kenwood transceiver. Jim was determined to get someone to get on, if possible. This was another of those fascinating DX stories...watch this column the next couple of weeks as the story unfolds yet again.

Don Miller, W9WNV, of 1960's DXpedition fame, was out on bail in his murder/conspiracy case. The California Supreme Court refused to hear an appeal, and his case was scheduled to go to trial.

We reported that rules changes by ARRL Headquarters to their DX Competition had been in opposition to recommendations of the Contest Advisory Committee, and it appeared that the Competition would be returned to its previous format in 1981. However, the Competition did not ever go back to its tradition of two weekends per mode, and the name change to "Contest" from "Competition" stuck, too.

Four stations were active from the United Arab Emirates: A6XJA, A6SB, A6SP, and A6XX, and four people were operating from the same site in Equatorial Guinea: 3C1s NE, NM, JP, and AB.
