BRIEF NOTES... From the *Southern California DX Club Bulletin*: "Last call for BX-80!! Pre-registration forms are coming in at a record clip. Get yours in now or you may not get into the main banquet room and may miss out on the pre-registration prizes." They refer to the famous Fresno DX Convention, 18-20 April...Those of you waiting to be re-stocked on report forms and envelopes will be rewarded in a couple of days, and the package will include postage-paid reply envelopes. Thanks for your patience...East Malaysian operation, 9M6MU, will commence 20 April for one week, by N2CW, N200, KP2A and VS5TX. Two transmitters and round-the-clock operation are promised...3B8DA has left for school in England and won't be back on Mauritius until October; Alex says all QSLs received by 15 March will be answered...Prefix hunters will be interested in an operation from Pine Island, off the coast of Cuba, by CO2CF/4, 1-3 April on 40 and 20 Meters; QSL Box 1, Havana...If you work 5W1BZ and desire a QSL, send it to the 5W1 Address, not to New Zeland, as some have done...Peter, S2BTF, is home in Germany presently; when he returns, word is he will be signing HS1AMB/S2 on the amateur bands... After operating as 4S7DX, KP2A will appear from the Maldives as 8Q7AP, 1-13 April. Then John joins the 9M6MU operation...Correction from *The DX Bulletin*, Issue 29, K7CW is operating from Brazil as PR8ZPJ and PR8ZPJ/9. Also, A4XGY QSL Manager (Issue 25) is K2RU, NOT K2RV...N200 says VS6AG will operate from Macao, CR9, starting 20 April for three days...All K4MM/3B8 and FR0MM cards have been answered by K1MM as of 14 Mar; Bill handles his own cards for all operations, including CE3ZM, CE0ZM, VS5MM, FP0MM, KG4MM, FM7MM, FG0MM, FG0MM/FS7, KZ5NO, HI8XWP, 0E1ZZB, YS9WP, FR0MM, FO0DX, OA4ASX, and 4U1ITU for the 1979 WPX SSB Contest only...During the recent ARRL contest, a number of stations in the USSR were asked about the UA/YA callsigns being heard on the bands; all the answers were negative...KA6HIQ/KH3 is on Johnston Island and shows several times a week around 21130; he is a Novice but does a good job of handling the callers...TN8AJ is back in Germany but should appear from Mali in about two weeks...The list operation mentioned on page one for TY9ER is run by DK2OC, and it goes smoothly but very slowly... Try 28770 on Tues., Thurs. and Sat. at 1500 UTC...
