The first seven issues last summer were produced and mailed by Don Busick, K5AAD, Tom Taormina, K5RC, and other members of the Texas DX Society; without them there would have been no Bulletin at all. We knew that over the long pull a group effort would not work, so now the Bulletin operation is consolidated in one place and one person.

PROPAGATION: Aug. 23, 24, High/Low Normal; Aug. 25, 26, High Normal; Aug. 27, 28, High/Low Normal; Aug. 29, Low Normal; Aug. 30, Below Normal/Disturbed; Aug. 31, Low Normal; Sept. 1, 2, 3, Low Normal; Sept. 4, 5, 6, High/Low Normal. TNX N4XX.

ZK1CF, presently active from the North Cooks, is Roger Ulsky, KB7JX, on a Pacific boat tour (see TDXB Issue 35, p. 5). Their plans originally called for further operations from Niue, British Phoenix, and Kermadec. The Kermadec stop has apparently been scrapped. ZK1CF has been very weak on the East Coast, using 50 watts to a dipole. He has shown on both the 14220/0700 and the 14285/0600 gatherings, as well as on 14250, 21300 and 28550. QSL manager is now ZL2AQF instead of K6FM as originally planned.

BAJO NUEVO/SERRANA BANK postponed two weeks; HK0AB Bajo Nuevo is now to run 0000Z Aug. 29 through 1700Z Sept. 2. Serrana Bank HK0AA will follow 0000Z Sept. 4 to 1700Z Sept. 7. QSLs to HK3BDD, Box 584, Bogota, Colombia.

JUAN DE NOVA schedule (TDXB Issue 51) is to start Sept. 11 or 12, using FR0RX/J and FR0CIW/J, plus one more undetermined callsign (on CW). After leaving Juan de Nova Sept. 19, the German group will operate D68AS and D68AT from the Comoroes, then two or three days on Mayotte signing /FH0. DK9KD, QSL manager for this operation as well as the April Glorioso trip, says the two expeditions have cost about \$50,000.

A22GTF (Gabarone Trade Fair) runs Aug. 27-31, 0600-1500Z, on 3800, 7095, 14280, 21310 and 28660, plus CW on unspecified frequencies.

DXCC DESK says that despite word coming from out of the United Arab Emirates, mainly Abu Dabi, no documentation for any A6 station has been received since before February, 1979, which was when the government there suspended amateur radio.




