HOT NEWS? CALL THE DX BULLETIN: 203-871-6251; LEAVE A MESSAGE!

PROPAGATION FORECAST: Sept. 22, High/Low Normal; Sept. 23, Low Normal; Sept. 24, High Normal; Sept. 25, High/Above Normal; Sept. 26-28, High Normal; Sept. 29, Above Normal; Sept. 30, Oct. 1-5, High Normal. TNX N4XX.

JUAN DE NOVA operation began Sept. 14 but encountered difficulties; details are sketchy at presstime but it is known that operating permission was not secured as easily as originally expected. The group apparently was forced to leave the island sometime the 15th or 16th, but was back on the air signing FRØRX/J on the 16th. They were heard most often on ten meters, with a weak signal but fairly workable in North America. Often the callsign was not heard for long periods, as the operators fell prey to the recent syndrome of forgetting to state their call. Very little if any operation took place from the Comoroës before Juan de Nova, this being due to the recent activity by N6ZV and AA6AA reducing the demand for that island.

9U5AV was put on the air Saturday September 13 and worked by many on the 14th; operator Vince, K5VT, had not made his intentions known in order to avoid any advance publicity possibly compromising his chances of authorized operation. In the past K5VT's operations have been properly documented so one must hope that this one will be also. QSL cards from 9U5DS operations last spring and early summer have been received by many but DXCC Desk still awaits papers and cards should NOT be sent for 9U5DS contacts.

AA6AA AND N6ZV returned to the U.S. West Coast Sept. 19 following their successful operations from 3B8, 3B9 and Tromelin. They tried twice for permission to operate from 5R8 Malagasy, without luck. All cards for 3B8ZV, 3B9ZV, AA6AA/3B8, FR7BP/T, etc. go to ZL1BIL with SAE with callsign, etc., on the back.

PACIFIC/INDIAN OCEAN operations mentioned in Issue 54 are apparently underway; A letter from Japan elaborates on the details and says JA3KWJ, Kazuo Kokaji, who was active from Africa late last year, is part of the operation. The schedule in Issue 54 still pertains. 8Q7BB worked last week was this group of wandering DXers. Their next stops are Australia from Sept. 19, P29 from Sept. 23 and H44 from Sept. 27. Kazuo is using an FT-101ZD, dipoles for 40 and 80 Meters, and a 14AVQ vertical on the higher bands. QSLs to JA3KWJ, Kazuo Kokaji, 6-16 Higashinakano, Yokaichi, Shiga 527, Japan. Other operators participating are JA7SGV, JH7BBK, and DU1JB.

CHINA continues to make news, with the following release:

"The China News Service (Xinhua) has invited a group of editors, writers and hams to a news seminar in Peking. Included are two radio days, and trips to the great wall, ming tomb and other places. Lunch in the Summer Palace, Nanjing, Shanghai, Canton. The group will leave September 25, for seventeen days, and return through Hong Kong. (cont'd)
