RESULTS-SECOND ANNUAL

## TDXB COUNTRIES-NEEDED SURVEY

Last May, 2200 DXers were asked to tell us what DXCC countries they are in need of. About 900 responded and this issue is devoted to the results of that survey. This task was performed manually, with about 25,000 "tick marks" wearing out several pencils. No claim is made for absolute accuracy!

A word about methodology... in an attempt to achieve valid results, only surveys from DXers needing 100 or fewer countries were used for the tabulation. The final number of surveys used, 785, is close enough to last year's 822 to allow for near-direct comparisons. As last year, only the top 73 needed DXCC countries were tabulated. In addition, the top twenty five for each of thirteen "areas" were tabulated separately.

Table 1, on page four, is the overall ranking of need for all 785 surveys tabulated. For comparison, the 1980 survey rankings are included; column 1 is the number needing each country in 1980 (out of 822 surveys). Column 2 is, of course, the country prefix. Column 4 is the country prefix for the 1981 survey, Column 5 the raw total for 1981 (out of 785 entries) and the last column indicates the country's movement either toward the top of the list (+) or movement down the list (-) from 1980.

Table 1 illustrates one important point: 1980 was exceptionally kind to DXers, at least those who read *TDXB* and who responded to the Survey. Note that through the first twenty listings, the percentage of need remained relatively constant. This is due to the lack of activity from all but a handful of the "Top Twenty." However, move down the rankings and note that the percentage need becomes less and less. For example, in

1980, 271 respondents (33 percent) needed country #40, while in the 1981 Survey only 175 (22 percent) needed the same-ranked country. As for country #73, at the bottom of the list, the percentages are 19 (1980) and 10 (1981). These deductions are valid because in both surveys only those needing 100 or fewer countries were tabulated. It appears that our subscribers have moved steadily up the ladder over the past twelve months!

Table 2, on the inside two pages, has, in addition to the top twenty five needed for thirteen areas, information on number of survey sheets received from each area and the average number of DXCC entities needed by respondents in that area. Some lessons for potential DXpeditioners can be found here, e.g., Malpelo is very difficult for the U.S. West Coast, and the Pacific is troublesome for European DXers.

*TDXB* hopes you find this information both interesting and useful.
